Insolvency Law

The State Ministry of Justice of Northrhine - Westphalia (Germany) has initiated an "International Exchange of Experience on Insolvency Law" (IEEI). The purpose of the IEEI is the informal, mainly e-mail - based exchange of ideas and information on international insolvency law and the national insolvency law systems. Since the beginning of the IEEI in the year 2000 more than 30 representatives (judges, administrators, state officials) from over 20 countries have joined our discussion group and sent numerous e-mails with questions, answers and comments on a large number of insolvency law problems. In January 2001 a first Online-Colloquium took place at our Academy of Justice. The members of the IEEI discussed various insolvency law related questions. During the colloquium a lot of e-mails were received and sent from and to all other participants of the IEEI, who (from South Africa to the U.S.A.) were online during the colloquium. Further Online-Colloquia took place in September 2001 and May 2002 in Germany, in May 2003 in Vienna/Austria, in June 2004 in Helsinki/Finland, in May 2005 in Ljubljana/Slovenia, in May 2006 in Rome/Italy and in May 2007 in Berlin/Germany. After the colloquia the discussion has been continued and is going on via e-mail.
